- 2 John Pott Historical Tablet**
Corner Arch and Centre Streets. Dedicated to John Pott founder of Pottsville.
- 3 Pottsville Historical Marker**
Former Dr. Nicholas Building. 209 West Market Street.
- 4 Pottsville Free Public Library**
Corner 3rd and West Market Street. Call (570) 622-8880 for more information. Historical and Genealogical Research available.
- 5 Joint Veterans Council Building**
First Fire House/City Hall
Pottsville Historical Marker at 14 North Third Street
- 6 Mud & Maker**
6 South Centre Street. Pottery studio and local art.
- 7 Marguerite's Antiques & Collectibles**
Former Green's Jewelry Store 1860 circa
Pottsville Historical Marker at 8 South Centre Street
- 8 Great Pottsville Fire Site**
Pottsville Historical Marker at 19 South Centre Street
Present site of Towne Drugs.
- 9 Necho Allen / White Horse Hotel Site**
Pottsville Historical Marker at 101 South Centre Street
- 10 John O'Hara Sculpture**
Corner Howard Avenue and Centre Street. Dedicated to Pottsville Author/Novelist.
- 11 Miner's National Bank Doors With Pottsville Historical Marker**
Corner Howard Avenue and Centre Street. Bronze relief showing underground mining. Cast in 1928, these Bronze reliefs depict deep mining operations.
- 12 Schuylkill County Water Authority Plaza and Pottsville Town Clock**
Features Cascading waterfall and City Clock.
- 13 Pottsville Broadcasting**
212 South Centre Street. City's first radio station 1946.
- 14 Black Rock Brewing Company** 🍺
Union Station, 325 S. Centre Street - The old Schaeffer Mansion
- 15 Union Station Transportation Center** 🚊 and Train Stop
Located at 300 S. Centre Street
- 16 Former American House Hotel**
Pottsville Historical Marker at 300 South Centre Street
- 17 Pottsville Historical Marker**
315 South Centre Street. Built 1829.
- 18 Farlow's Famous Philadelphia** 🍔 Style Deli. & Hoagies
Subs Hot-Cold. 200 South Centre Street. (570) 294-7720.
- 19 Henry Clay Monument**
Erected in 1855 to honor US Senator from Kentucky. South Centre St. Hill. Clay's support of protective tariffs on imported manufactured goods helped fuel the American Industrial Revolution.
- 20 Henry Clay Monument Overlook**
Scenic vantage point for view of monument.
- 21 Pottsville Hospital Mural**
By Dave Naydock. Corner of Baber & Mauch Chunk Streets.
- 22 Atkins Mansion**
Built by Charles Atkins in 1865. 396 South Centre Street

The Former Morgan Studebaker Dealership. Early 1900's and Carriage House for the Atkins Mansion

- 26 Reading Anthracite Museum**
200 Mahantongo Street. R/R Coal & Iron Building, Built 1905.
- 27 United Presbyterian Church**
Corner 3rd and Mahantongo Streets. Lewis Comfort Tiffany Stained Glass Windows.
- 28 D.G. Yuengling & Sons Brewery** 🍺 With Exterior and Interior Murals
America's Oldest Brewery founded in 1829. Located 5th & Mahantongo Streets. Tours available, call (570) 628-4890.
- 29 Former Home of John O'Hara**
606 Mahantongo Street. Pennsylvania Historical Marker.
- 30 Burd Patterson Historical Marker**
Located in front of 803 Mahantongo Street. Pennsylvania Historical Marker.
- 31 St. John the Baptist R.C. Church**
Featuring the stained glass windows by Wilhelm Derix. Corner 10th & Mahantongo. Only complete set of Derix Stained Glass windows remaining in the world.
- 32 Yuengling Bicentennial Park and Garden**
Located at 10th and Mahantongo Streets. Walking trails, gazebo, park benches.
- 33 Schuylkill County Council for the Arts**
Located at the Frank Yuengling Mansion, 1440 Mahantongo Street. Call (570) 622-2788 for tours and programs.
- 34 Former Site of Dolan's Park and Pottsville Maroons Practice Field**
Pottsville Historical Marker at 1822 W. Market Street
- 35 Pottsville Area School District Mural**
By Dave Naydock. 16th Street near Elk Avenue.
- 36 Martz Hall Sports Facility**
16th Street and Laurel Boulevard. Site of Basketball and International Gymnastic Events.
- 37 Charles Baber Cemetery** 🏠
Located along West Market Street between 13th and 15th. Cemetery tours and events. Burial site for many prominent Schuylkill Countians including John Pott.
- 37a Charlie's Pizza & Sub Shop** 🍕
Since 1965. Historic diner on Pennsylvania Registry. 1401 West Market Street. (570) 622-3609.
- 38 Wheel Restaurant & Bar** 🍷
201 West Market Street. (570) 622-2700.
- 38a Roma Pizza & Restaurant** 🍕
116 West Market Street. (570) 628-5551.
- 39 Garfield Square Monuments**
Located at 5th and Market Street. Soldier and Sailors' Monument erected by Civil War Veterans in 1891.
- 40 Schuylkill County Prison**
Located Sanderson Street near 2nd Street, Built in 1850-51. Site of Molly Maguire hangings in 1870s.

- 41 Schuylkill County Courthouse**
Located at Laurel Boulevard near 2nd Street. Built in 1889-1891.
- 42 The Pottsville Zone** 🍷

Dedicated to the 1925 Pottsville Maroons NFL Football Team.

Located 209 North Centre Street. Built in 1910. Renovated theater, performing arts site.
